# MONTHLY HOA FEES INCREASE - JAN. 2020

Starting in January 2020 the new monthly HOA fee for Highland Estates will be **\$88.00**. If you are on automatic payments, contact North HOA at **service@northhoa.com** and we will help you update your automatic payments.

#### WHY ARE MY DUES INCREASING?

In 2019 the board conducted a reserve study to analyze what maintenance and repairs the community will need in upcoming years and how much those repairs will cost to complete. Some of these repairs include the roofs, concrete repair and replacement, common area fence, playground replacement, new siding, entrance rails, gutters, parking asphalt overlay, trim paint and backyard privacy fences. The board determined that Highland Estates is underfunded at only 20% of what will be needed. With the current dues increase that will take place in January plus additional changes as needed, it will be possible to have enough money in reserves to meet the first large replacement costs.
