LAWN & YARD CARE

Thank you to those who have kept up with your lawns!

We would like to remind all homeowners that our Rules & Regulations state:

YARDS: All external areas shall have landscaping that is kept to the standard (general decor) of the community, and shall always be neat and maintained. This includes lawns, trees, and ornamental shrubs. Exterior areas are to be free from trash, dead vegetation, refuse, and waste. All landscaped areas are to be watered and maintained. Lawn and garden areas are to be kept alive, free of weeds, and attractive. Lawns shall be mowed regularly; grass may be allowed to grow no higher than 6''. Trees and shrubs shall be pruned as needed.



<u>Guidelines for Keeping Lawn and Garden Areas Alive, Free</u> of Weeds, and Attractive: Areas required to be landscaped are front yards, side yards, and rear yards. Missing turf should be replaced, if necessary. Shrubs and trees that have died should be replaced, or the area converted to grass. Owners wishing to convert to Water Wise Landscaping shall submit a plan to the Architectural Control Committee for prior approval.

SUMMER TIPS

Summer is around the corner! Here are some tips for beating the summer heat!

- FEEL THE FREEZER BURN: Stick your sheets in a plastic bag and place them in the fridge or freezer for a few minutes before bed.
- **PAMPER YOUR PULSE**: To cool down FAST apply ice packs to pulse points at the wrists, neck, elbows, ankles, and behind the knees.
- TURN OFF THE LIGHTS: Light bulbs give off heat. Turn them off during the day to keep it cool after dark.

- Pests: Embrace good bugs like ladybugs, bees, praying mantises and spiders while avoiding unwanted bugs like aphids or Japanese beetles!
